



Key Questions to Ask

Here are some key questions to ask your teacher, principal and/or administrators to get to know your school's tech policy and start the conversation:

1. How much time is being spent on screens at each grade level?
2. What apps are being used and for what purpose?
3. What protocols exist around device use?
4. Are non-educational, preloaded apps removed from devices before being given to students?
5. Do devices go home with students or stay on carts in classrooms?
6. Are devices allowed during recess, lunch, or the after school programs in an unsupervised manner?
7. Is screen time used as a reward or incentive for students?
8. What protections are in place on school issued devices that prevent students from intentionally or unintentionally accessing inappropriate content?
9. What protections are in place to protect student's data when using third party apps?
10. Is AI being used by students or teachers in the classroom and if so for what purpose?
